As the regular season wraps up with games on October 27th, it's time to think about playoffs! Assuming that the good weather on Saturdays continues, playoffs will be held on November 3rd and 4th at Cape Horn Park. If either October 27 or Nov 3 get rained out, playoffs will be moved to November 10th and 11th. This year, ALL leagues will have playoff opportunities.

Playoff Games ending in a tie will be resolved in the following manner:

- NO GOALIES, ALL AGE GROUPS: 5V5
- The players selected to play during the overtime period do not have to be on the field at the end of regulation. Each team will have a five minute intermission after the end of the regulation game. The referee(s) will conduct a coin toss. The winner of the coin toss will elect which goal they would like to defend. Overtime will begin with a drop-ball at midfield.
- There will be no substitutions. The only exception will be for an injured player. If the injured player leaves the field and is substituted for, the injured player cannot return. Fatigue is not an injury.
- No player is permitted to use their hands to prevent a goal. In the event that a player uses their hands to prevent the opposing team from scoring (defined as a ball traveling either in flight or on the ground in a direct path to the goal), that player will be red-carded for denying an obvious goal scoring opportunity and the offending will lose a player for the duration of the game. Should the offending player's team win, that player IS allowed to return for the following game.
- Penalty Kicks the defensive team will be allowed to place one defender in front of the goal on a penalty kick and that player is prohibited from using their hands to prevent the scoring of a goal.
- The team that scores first wins.
- The overtime period will be uninterrupted until a winner is determined (unlimited time)

Spring Soccer NCSC

Based on the survey that was sent out last month, NCSC will be having a Spring Soccer League in 2013. Details are still being worked out, but plan on the following:

- U8, U11, and U14 Leagues ages based on Fall season age groups
- Starting mid-March with practices
- Games from April through mid-May
- Registration in January 2013
- LIMITED registration, once leagues are full registration will be closed
